## Instructions for full paper submission

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### Abstract

This note\* provides instructions for the preparation and submission of the final versions of the accepted papers for the 38<sup>th</sup> WIC<sup>†</sup> Symposium on Information Theory in the Benelux (SITB), and 7<sup>th</sup> joint WIC/IEEE SP Symposium on Information Theory and Signal Processing in the Benelux to be held in Delft, the Netherlands, May 11–12, 2017 (see <http://http://cas.tudelft.nl/sitb2017>).

## 1 Format

The paper format and style must be in accordance with the present document. You can use this L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X file to generate your camera-ready paper. The format and style specifications are:

- ◇ A4-size, one column, text width 155mm, text height 235mm, top and side margins 27mm, and a maximum of 8 pages;
- ◇ A serif font such as the standard L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X font or “Times” and a font size of 12pt; this will be reduced to 10pt in the proceedings;
- ◇ no page numbers, maximum of 8 pages, references like [?], sections and subsections should be numbered like in this sample.

## 2 Submission
